Candidates must be eligible for licensure in the province of Ontario and preferred candidates would possess a Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons fellowship, or equivalent, with additional fellowship training in **Critical Care, Chronic Pain, Pediatric Anesthesiology, or Clinical/Basic Research**.

Preference will be given to applicants with a major interest in research, as well as a commitment to education. Substantial resources are available to support suitably qualified candidates who wish to pursue a clinician scientist career. Referees who can attest to the applicant's expertise are required.
