As you are participating in a regional rotation in South Central Ontario [Peterborough, Lindsay, Cobourg, Markham] of at least 4 consecutive weeks, you and your assigned Preceptor are eligible for funding through the Rural Ontario Medical Program (ROMP).

A new collaboration agreement between Queen's and ROMP has been initiated.

What does ROMP fund?

ROMP assists Queen's University with the costs associated with your Peterborough or Markham accommodation and preceptor Stipends. The accommodations are arranged and furnished and maintained by Regional Education office of the Queen's School of Medicine.

ROMP provides the learner with a portion of the funds related to the learners travel expenses. Requests for additional travel expenditures can be made through Regional Education, School of Medicine, Queen's University regional@queensu.ca.

You will be provided with a learner expense report in your orientation package in Peterborough at the beginning of your rotation together with an evaluation form.

Funding through ROMP will only be extended to a learner and his/her preceptor if the learner has completed a ROMP application. Failure to complete an application form, [learner expense report and evaluation](#) will result in no funding from ROMP for the learner and the preceptor.
