## Instructions for Residents of Toronto – Police Record Check

The Queen's School of Medicine has an approved Memorandum of Understanding in place with the Toronto Police Service. In order to obtain a PRC from Toronto you will need to email the undergrad office to obtain a signed original copy of the "Consent to Disclosure of Personal Information" waiver form. This form must be in ORIGINAL copy, signed by a representative of the School of Medicine, and mailed to the recipient (we are unable to fax or electronically scan this document). Once the form has been received you can mail the completed form and the associated fees to the Toronto Police Service.
