The Queen's School of Medicine participates in the centralized application process for Ontario Medical Schools and will only accept applications which are submitted through the Ontario Medical School Application Service (OMSAS). Applications will only be accepted from applicants who have met the submission requirements as set out on the OMSAS website each admissions cycle and must meet the prerequisites for the Queen's School of Medicine MD program as laid out in our process and procedures. All applications are considered and reviewed by the Admissions Committee of the School of Medicine for entry into the first year of the program. Applications for advanced standing or transfer are not considered.

Applicants will be deemed ineligible for admissions into the Queen's School of Medicine program if they:

1. are a current student, past student, or graduate of an Undergraduate Medical Education program at a Canadian Medical School;

and/or
2. have been required to withdraw from an MD program (to be assessed on a case-by-case basis).
