Graduate applicants that have met the MCAT requirements, but not the undergraduate GPA will be reviewed separately, by a subcommittee of the Admissions Committee, from the general pool of applicants.

1. Applicants must have completed their graduate degree by the August 1 prior to the commencement of medical school;
2. Applicants must be in their final year of a multi-year graduate degree program to be eligible to apply as a graduate applicant;
3. Applicants that are in a 1-year graduate degree program must complete their graduate degree prior to applying to be eligible as a graduate applicant. Otherwise they will be considered as an undergraduate applicant;
4. Marks for undergraduate years must be considered satisfactory or demonstrate a rising trend;
5. The subcommittee will assess the suitability of the candidate's performance and if the graduate degree was completed at an accredited university;
6. If the subcommittee determines that the applicant is suitable, they will be invited for an interview.
