Requests for deferred registration will be considered by the Admissions Committee from highly qualified students wishing to complete the requirements for their undergraduate or graduate degree before enrolling in the School of Medicine. A maximum of ten students wishing to complete the requirements for their undergraduate or graduate degree may be accepted for deferred registration. Requests for deferral will be considered as they are received and must be received within 14 days of acceptance of your offer to be considered. Normally, deferred registration will be granted for one year.

Policy AD-09: Assessment of QuARMS Students applying to the Undergraduate Medical Education Program Policy supersedes this policy regarding QuARMS students receiving acceptance into our MD program. As such, requests for deferrals will not normally be granted for students in the QuARMS pathway. Consideration will be the decision of the Admissions Committee and would typically only be considered for significant extenuating circumstances. A request to finish your degree would not be considered.
