QuARMS students applying to Queen's Undergraduate Medical Education program will apply directly to the School of Medicine when they are in their 2nd year of undergraduate education. Applications will only be accepted from QuARMS students who have met the submission requirements as set out by the Admissions Committee.

Students will need to apply directly to the School of Medicine Admissions Committee. Students will NOT need to apply through OMSAS and will NOT need to write the MCAT. All students will be notified of the academic requirements and invited to an interview with the Admissions Committee if those requirements have been met.

All applications are considered and reviewed by the Admissions Committee of the School of Medicine for entry into the first year of the program. Applications Decisions made by the Admissions Committee are final and binding.

Request for deferrals from the QuARMS pathway into Undergraduate Medical Education will not normally be granted for the QuARMS pathway. Consideration will be the decision of the Admissions Committee and would typically only be considered for significant extenuating circumstances. A request to finish your degree would not be considered.

If it is discovered that any application information is false or misleading, concealed or withheld, the application will be disqualified. If it is discovered after an offer of admission has been sent or after you are admitted into the MD program, it will be handled as per policy AD-07.
