

Connecting to KHSC Corporate Wi-Fi

Google Android Instructions



1. Download and install the “Cisco Network Setup Assistant” app from the App Store or Google Play Store using your data plan or by connecting to the “KHSC-Guest” public Wi-Fi network

2. Tap the ‘Settings’ app, then ‘Connections’, then the ‘Wi-Fi’ option

3. Tap ‘Add Network...’, enter the below details and tap ‘Save’ and/or ‘Connect’:

<u>Network name:</u>	KHSC
<u>Security:</u>	802.1x EAP
<u>Username:</u>	<i>Your KHSC credentials: “HC\USERNAME”</i>
<u>Password:</u>	<i>Your KHSC password</i>
<u>EAP method:</u>	PEAP
<u>Phase 2 authentication:</u>	MSCHAPV2




4. Once connected, follow the prompts to sign onto the Wi-Fi or open a web browser and enter a website in the address bar (e.g. www.kgh.on.ca), you will be redirected to the “KHSC BYOD Portal”



5. Tap ‘MORE’ in the top right-hand corner, then in the pop-up tap “Keep connection”

6. Read the Acceptable Use Policy, then tap ‘Start’

7. Enter a ‘Device name’ and optionally a ‘Description’, then tap ‘Continue’



8. Since the “Cisco Network Assistant” app has already been downloaded, press the Home button and open the app, then tap the ‘Start’ button
9. Tap ‘Proceed’ to download the profile
10. Select the ‘Wi-Fi’ option from the ‘Used for’ dropdown, then tap ‘OK’
11. Enter your device passcode
12. Once again, select the ‘Wi-Fi’ option from the ‘Used for’ dropdown, then tap ‘OK’
13. Follow the on-screen instructions to “Forget network” and then tap the ‘Back’ button
14. Within 60 seconds, the device will be connected to the “KHSC” Wi-Fi network
15. Tap ‘Exit’ to close the “Cisco Network Setup Assistant” app and your device is ready to use the internet



Notes:

- To remove the Wi-Fi profile from your device: Go to Settings → Connections → Wi-Fi, hold the “KHSC” Wi-Fi name until the menu appears, then tap ‘Forget Network’
