The Queen's School of Medicine participates in the centralized application process for Ontario Medical Schools and will only accept applications that are submitted through the Ontario Medical School Application Service (OMSAS). The Admissions Committee will only accept applications from applicants who have met the submission requirements as set out on the OMSAS website and our website for applicable admissions cycles. They must also meet the prerequisites for the MD Program and all related and/or applicable programs, pathways, or streams, etc., as laid out in our process and procedures. No late applications will be accepted.

All complete applications are considered and reviewed by the MD Admissions Committee for entry into the first year of the program. Applications for advanced standing or transfer are not considered.

In order to be considered for admission to the Queen's Lakeridge Health MDFM program and the MD/PhD & MD/MSc program, applicants must direct their Queen's University admission application to these programs.

Offers are binding to the assigned campus and program.

Applicants will be deemed ineligible for admission into the MD Program and all related and/or applicable programs, pathways, or streams, etc., if they:

1. are a current student, past student, or graduate of an Undergraduate Medical Education program at a Canadian Medical School;
2. have been required to withdraw from an MD program (to be assessed on a case-by-case basis).
