QuARMS students applying to the MD Kingston program will apply directly to the School of Medicine when they are in their 2<sup>nd</sup> year of undergraduate education for consideration to the next 1<sup>st</sup> year MD Kingston class intake. Applications will only be accepted from QuARMS students who have met the submission requirements as set out by the MD Admissions Committee.

Students will need to apply directly to the School of Medicine MD Admissions Committee. Students will not need to apply through OMSAS and will not need to write the MCAT.

All students will be notified of the academic requirements and invited to an interview at the discretion of the Admissions Committee

Only complete applications submitted by the application deadline will be considered and reviewed by the MD Admissions Committee of the School of Medicine for entry into the first year of the MD Kingston program. Addendums or supplemental materials sent after the application deadline (unless requested by the Admissions Committee), or incomplete applications will not be considered. Admissions decisions made by the Admissions Committee are final and binding.

Request for deferrals from the QuARMS Pathway into the MD Program will not normally be granted. Consideration will be the decision of the Admissions Committee and would typically only be considered for significant extenuating circumstances. A request to finish your degree would not be considered.

If it is discovered that any application information is false or misleading, concealed or withheld, the application will be disqualified. If it is discovered after an offer of admission has been sent or after the student is admitted into the MD program, it will be handled as per policy AD-07.
